- High Tech enterprise: up to 500K RMB .
- Technical transformation of fixed assets subsidy: up to ٠ 5% of the investment on fixed assets transformation
- Manufacturing Industry Innovation Center Support: up • to 20 million RMB
- Applicable industry: Equipment manufacturing, pan-• home, automotive and new energy, civil-military integration and electronic information, intelligent manufacturing equipment and robots, new materials, food and beverage, biomedicine and health
- Small and Micro size enterprise employment . subsidy: social insurance for the employees who are new graduates within 2 years, with employment contract for more than 1 year.



- · Quality Award Incentive: Up to 1 million RMB Manufacturing, service, construction enterprises:
- Technical Equipment Transformation Incentive: up to 10% of the total investment on equipment transformation. maximum 5 million RMB.
- Financial Lease Incentive: up to 1 million RMB
- SME Growth Incentive: up to 50K RMB (50% of costs on lease or equipment purchase)





· Incentives: including but not limited to subsidies for project landing, fixed asset investment, transitional rent, equity investment, financing, technological transformation, standardized management, core equipment usage, business contribution awards, mergers and restructure, etc. up to 10 million RMB.





Companies of only 6 industries are allowed to access the Area:



Additional Requirements

A virtual address agreement must be signed with the Qianhai Area management authority.

Registered capital no longer needs to be RMB 5 mil. No minimum capital needed.

Tax Incentives/Government Subsidies In Shenzhen

Qianhai Free Trade Zone

Companies registered in Qianhai Shenzhen-Hongkong Modern Service Industry Cooperation Zone ("Qianhai FTZ") enjoy corporate tax rate of 15% if listed in the Preferential Catalogue of Qianhai.

The income from preferential industries must constitute more than 70% of the total income of qualified companies.

This preferential policy shall be valid until December 31, 2021.

Tax Incentives/government subsidies in Shenzhen

Modern Logistics

- Supply Chain Management Services like Supply Chain solution design, order management and execution, virtual manufacturing, information management, consulting services, etc.
- · Onshore and offshore logistics outsourcing service;
- Development and operation of modern logistics technology and logistics public service system;
- Settlement and management of third-party logistics

 Professional technology services in different industries, including new energy, advanced materials, biological medicine and lowcarbon environmental protection, etc.

 Research, development and service of emerging science and technology like gene sequencing, stem cells, functional protein, life health, etc.

• Research, development and service of new energy battery, threedimensional display and print technology;

 Advanced technology service of information technology outsourcing, business process outsourcing, knowledge process outsourcing, etc.



Government Subsidy in Shenzhen (non-exhaustive list)



Hengqin (Zhuhai) can offer you the following advantages:



- Administration of bonded or tax-exempt production-related goods entering Hengqin from abroad; (which eases import/export and e-commerce)
- Transactions among enterprises located within the Hengqin FTZ are exempted from any value-added and/or consumption tax.
- Clearance procedures for residents of Hong Kong and Macao entering and leaving Hengqin are simplified, with 24-hour passage at the Hengqin Checkpoint.
- Certain talents from outside mainland China will be entitled to a financial subsidy equal to the amount of individual income tax (IIT) payable in Zhuhai in excess of 15% of their taxable income. This subsidy will be exempt from any IIT obligation.

 Production-related goods sold from areas of the Chinese mainland to Hengqin are treated as exports and enjoy tax refunds.

 Hong Kong/Macao residents working in Hengqin receive the appropriate China Individual Income Tax (IIT) deduction from the Guangdong Provincial Government so that their effective China IIT burden would be close to what they would pay if they instead had been working where they are domiciled.

 Administrative regulations have been issued for Macao vehicles with single license plates (to be operated exclusively within Hengqin).

Guangzhou Subsidies for Enterprises R&D Expenditure

The Guangzhou Municipal Science and Technology Bureau offers a series of subsidies (from 100,000 RMB to 20 million RMB) to local enterprises for their R&D expenditure. The subsidies are aimed at simulating more sustained R&D investments by local actors, so to reach the municipality's development target of <u>3% R&D</u> intensity on local GDP.

Eligibility requirements:

- Enterprise with independent legal personality in Guangzhou;
- R&D expenses exceeding 2% of annual operational revenue (and at least exceeding 2 million RMB);
- Has already registered the R&D expenditure with local tax authorities.

What are the benefits?

Post-expenditure subsidies:

- 100,000 RMB for R&D expenditure > 2 million RMB but < 5 million RMB
- 400,000 RMB for R&D expenditure > 5 million RMB but < 10 million RMB
- 1 million RMB for R&D expenditure > 10 million RMB but < 50 million RMB
- 3 million RMB for R&D expenditure > 50 million RMB but < 100 million RMB
- 7 million RMB for R&D expenditure > 100 million RMB but < 500 million RMB
- 20 million RMB for R&D expenditure > 500 million RMB

Similar subsidies exist for : Universities & Research institutes + Industry

Universities & Research institutes + International cooperation

Other policies include:

•The city is attracting young Hong Kongers by offering generous subsidies on business costs (rent. Etc), access to trade officials and a favorable environment to raise capital

•The Guangzhou government has been at the forefront of establishing <u>incubation hubs</u> for young entrepreneurs from Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan


 In December 2020, the Nansha regions officially released "20 Measures for Gathering International Talents in Guangzhou Nansha New Area ", which includes the following:

- Resettlement subsidy up to 5 million Yuan;
 - Housing rent support;
- · Many new job positions being posted in the area.










Trade Balance: British Exports to China

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





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RESCISSION AND TERMINATION OF LABOUR CONTRACTS

Negotiation between both parties

Employee notify employer with a 30-day advance notice in writing to rescind his/her labor contract

Employer notify employee with a 30-day advance notice in writing and one month's wage to rescind the labor contract

Other situations

Minefields in the HR perspective

- Dismiss employees without severance
- Non-renewal upon the contract expiration date
- Forgot to sign labor contract
- Signing the 3rd fixed term labor contract
- Probation period again

Social Insurance

Article 12

- Contributing entities and individuals must pay their social insurance premiums in cash and in full.
- The social insurance premiums payable by contributing individuals shall be withheld from their wages and paid for them by their entities.
- Social insurance premiums may not be reduced or exempted.

SI contribution



- Pension-ER
- Un-employment-ER
- Injury-ER
- Maternity-ER
- Medical-ER
- Pension-EE
- Un-employment-EE
- Medical-EE

Housing Fund Calculation formula: Last Year's average monthly salary* percentage

Article 20:

ER portion + EE portion

An employer shall pay and deposit housing provident fund on schedule and in full, and may not be overdue in the contribution or underpay the housing provident fund.




Visible Cost: maintaining recruitment channel, headhunting, HR's salaries, fixed expenses...

- IIT Subsidies in Greater Bay Area: China has rolled out income tax incentives to lure outstanding overseas talents to work in the Guangdong-Hongkong-Macau Bay Area (GBA).
- To attract Chinese talents, Hukou and local incentives are workable.

• Social insurance, housing fund, commercial insurance, supplement pension, supplement housing fund, accommodation, allowance, bonus, health examination, team build, full paid additional annual leave, full paid sick leave, flexible working hours, paid overtime and so on.




Retaining and Developing Talents

Job-hopping Tendency

- The average service month of first job for talents who born after 1995 is 15 months.
- Young people tend to change job.

Methods:

- Training: job skills and soft skills;
- Salary Adjustment (5.9% for 2019, 4.7% for 2020, estimated 5.1% for 2021);
- Career Advancement;
- Build Company Culture;
- Welfares.
